

Congress is trying to repeal the Affordable Care Act (ACA/Obamacare), and cut Medicaid and other healthcare programs for kids.

Currently, more than 97% of New York children have healthcare coverage because of the ACA, Medicaid, and other programs for children.

New York State could lose at least \$3.7 billion from the federal government if these changes happen.

- Less money for New York State means cuts to insurance plans and Medicaid
 - Employers may stop offering health insurance
 - o Subsidies for individuals to buy health insurance may go away
 - Medicaid and Child Health Plus in New York may not have enough money to cover all children currently covered
- Less money for New York State means insurance benefits will get worse
 - o Risk losing coverage for prenatal, maternity, and newborn care
 - Risk losing prescription drug coverage
 - Possible cuts to dental and vision coverage for kids
 - Folks may have to pay more for visits to the doctor and hospital—which can really add up if they have chronic conditions like asthma and diabetes
