NEW YORK CITY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION STUDENT SAFETY ACT DATA: **SCHOOL YEAR 2017-2018**



Every October 31st, the New York City Department of Education is required to release Student Safety Act data for the previous school year, making public the use of suspensions and classroom removals1 in New York City public schools. The latest numbers show that the use of suspensions grew 4.1% and classroom removals grew 11.4% during the 2017-2018 school year compared to the year before, a discouraging development that comes after years of steady decline in the City's reliance on exclusionary discipline. This new collection of data also followed an announcement made by the Department of Education in March reporting that the use of suspensions had increased by 20.9% in the first half of the school year alone, compared to the same period the prior year.

Just one day before the data was released, students rallied to raise alarm in response to new information from the Independent Budget Office showing that in the 2016-2017 school year Black students received longer suspensions on average for 8 of the top 10 infractions in the Discipline Code, and for three infractions in particular Black students were suspended for roughly twice the number of days as other students. While the Student Safety Act data does not disaggregate suspension duration by student race or infraction type, New York City students continue to bring these disparities to light.

This new Student Safety Act data reports 49,293 total classroom removals and suspensions, where Black students were 3.4 times more likely to be suspended and 3.7 times more likely to be removed multiple times than white students - the same rates of disproportionality as the 2016-2017 school year. While suspensions of 30 days or longer have decreased 28.7% as compared to the year prior, racial disparities remain and Black students were 5.0 times more likely to receive a long-term suspension than white students in the 2017-2018 school year, compared to 5.1 times more likely in the 2016-2017 school year. In marked contrast, schools in District 18 currently participating in the District 18 Restorative Practices Pilot experienced close to a 19% decrease in reported removals and suspensions.²

As the District 18 results show, to end racial disparities in school discipline and the reliance on harmful and exclusionary discipline policies, the Department of Education must invest in a more comprehensive plan to support restorative justice models in schools, and provide tools and resources to educators, students, and their communities that can best prevent and respond to conflict that happens in schools.

- ¹ A classroom removal is a process where a teacher requests a student be removed from the classroom consistent with the Discipline Code, where removed students are sent to a location within the school where they are supposed to be provided with continued instructional services. - ² Because of school-level redactions in the data, this is an approximate number.
- Short-term suspensions are known as "principal's suspensions" and refer to suspensions lasting 1 to 5 school days.
 Long-term suspensions are known as "superintendent's suspensions" and refer to suspensions exceeding five school days, with the exception of a superintendent's suspension with immediate reinstatement to the suspending school.
